
## **BELMONT ESTATE CATALOGUE, 1979**

This is from the family papers of a local resident, by whose kind permission these pages concerning Callow and Haywood have been reproduced.



#### **Historical Note**

Belmont, raised on a prominence above a beautiful stretch of the River Wye with views to the hills of Radnorshire in the far distance, has been in Prosser and Wegg-Prosser hands since 1826 when the Clehonger Manor Estate of nearly 900 acres—of which Belmont formed a part—was purchased by the Venerable Dr. Prosser, Archdeacon of Durham, from the then owner, Colonel John Matthews for a sum of £42,500, at a public auction held at The Green Dragon, Hereford.

Colonel Matthews had himself purchased the Estate at the latter end of the eighteenth century and in 1788 erected the mansion at Belmont to replace the older house which had been burned down in 1785.

The new purchaser, Dr. Prosser, on his death bequeathed Belmont to his nephew—Francis Richard Haggitt—conditionally upon him changing his name to Wegg-Prosser. He acquired the Estate by inheritance in 1847.

The mansion as built by Colonel Matthews to the designs of Wyatt, was altered in appearance and enlarged in the mid-1850's, becoming known as one of the finest examples of Tudor Gothic revival in the Midlands, the handsome parti-coloured stone of local quarrying rendering it—as reported in the 'Hereford Mercury' of September 1st, 1875—'a sweet moss-rose looking out from its sheltered retreat.'

In 1852, Francis Richard Wegg-Prosser was converted to Rome, and thus began the long and much honoured association with the Roman Catholic Church, his own lasting memorial being Belmont Abbey, which he built and financed from his own resources to designs by Pugin and completed in 1859.

On his death in 1911, the Estate passed down to his son, Mr. John Francis Wegg-Prosser, whose only son, Cecil Francis, was the father in his turn of an only daughter, Sonia, who in 1940 married Lieut.-Colonel Arthur Edward Raleigh Chichester of the Worcestershire Regiment. Upon coming into the Estate, John Francis left Herefordshire for another establishment nearer London, but Colonel and Mrs. Chichester eventually re-occupied the Belmont Mansion where the late Mrs. Chichester, already widowed some years earlier, died in 1977.

The present contents are largely from the Chichester marriage, for in 1912, Mr. J. F. Wegg-Prosser leased Belmont, and a sale of the then contents was held at the house almost exactly sixty-seven years ago, when the total realised—after expenses—was £2,430 16s. 0d.


