


## The Minute Book of Callow Village School

# TITHE ACT, 1936

### Explanatory Memorandum

All tithe reatcharges and extraordinary rentcharges charged on land immediately before the 2nd October, 1986, were extinguished on that date and, in lieu, redemption annuties were charged under Section 3 of the Tithe Act, 1986, for the period commencing on that day and ending on the 1st October, 1988.

A redemption annuity is payable to the Tithe Redemption Commission by half-yearly metalments on the 1st April and 1st October of each year (Section 16 (i)). The amount of each instalment is calculated in accordance with Section 47 (4) of the Act, which provides that fractions of a penny less than a halfpenny shall be discepteded, and fractions of a penny amounting to a halfpenny or more shall be treated as a whole penny.

### 2. Liability in respect of Redemption Annuities

An instalment of an annuity payable on any payment date is a debt due to the Crown from the person who is on that date the owner of any land in respect of the countries of the Crown from the person who is on that date the owner of any land in respect of the countries of the cou

to the Crown from the person on whom such a notice is effectively series.

The fact that a landower makes repayments to a mortgagee (e.g., a Building Society, local Council), in respect of a loan for the purchase of the property does not mean that the mortgage is responsible for payment of the retemption annuity charged in respect of the property. In such cases, the deeds of the property are held by the mortgage as security for the loan and commership of the property remains with the person to whom it was conveyed.

The MINISTER OF EDUCATION hereby ORDERS as follows:

I. Other expressions to which meanings are assigned by the Education Acts, 1944 to 1948, shall have the same meanings for the purposes of this Instrument.

The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply to the interpretation of this Instrum Act of Parliament.

Body of Managers

2. The body of Managers of each School (hereinafter called "the School ") specified in the first column of the Schoole to this Instrument shall, when complete, consist of :—

One acceptate Foundation Manager, being the Principal Officiating Minister of the ecclesiastical parish or district within which the School is for the time being situated. Provided that if the said Minister reduces to act, or is absent from all the meetings of the Manager during a period of twelve months, or there is a vacancy of the benefice, the Archdescon of the Archdescon within which the School is strusted may from time to time apoint, some person to act as substitute for the said Minister for such period as in thinks fit; and

One person, being a member of the Church of England, to be appointed by the Hereford Diocesan Council of Education after consultation with the Paraghial Church Council of the said ecclesiastical parish or district; and

FOUR Representative Managers to be appointed :-

Two by the Minor Authority specified in the second column of the Schedule in this Instrument, and

Two by the Local Education Authority

Managers, other than ex-officio Managers, need not be members of the appointing body.

3. Every Manager to be appointed by the Local Education Authority shall be appointed for a term of office ending on the date of the appointment of his successor, which may be made at any time after the ordinary day of retirement of County Councilions next after his appointment. The other Managers, other than the ex-spfree Managers, shall hold office for a term of three years.
